- 2. Deadline to submit LFS Reimbursement Requests **May 9**, **2025**

Notifications

- Click "send me a copy of my responses" box when filling out form to receive email copy receipt
- If denied, informed with a denial email notification with reason
- If accepted and approved by finance, email with the request details, total amount requested, and amount of LFS funds you have left to spend
- Reimbursement should be received within 30 days of Finance approval

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To file a program discrimination complaint, a Complainant should complete a Form AD-3027, USDA Program Discrimination Complaint Form which can be obtained online at: https://www.usda.gov/sites/default/files/documents/USDA-OASCR%20P-Complaint-Form-0508-0002-508-11-28-17Fax2Mail.pdf, from any USDA office, by calling (866) 632-9992, or by writing a letter addressed to USDA. The letter must contain the complainant's name, address, telephone number, and a written description of the alleged discriminatory action in sufficient detail to inform the Assistant Secretary for Civil Rights (ASCR) about the nature and date of an alleged civil rights violation. The completed AD-3027 form or letter must be submitted to USDA by:
