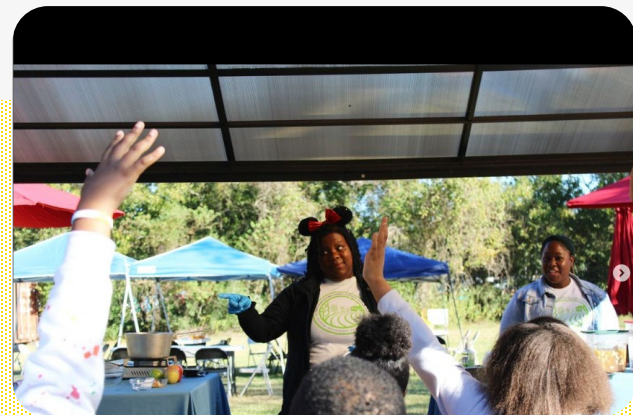


Farm Fresh Challenge 2022



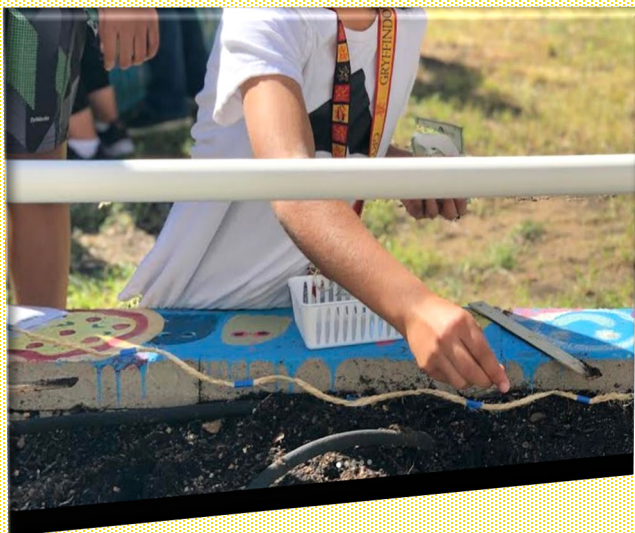
Houston ISD
